Detailed itinerary – The Ultimate Husky Challenge

28 March: Depart London to Kiruna

Fly from London to Kiruna in Sweden.
Upon arrival we are met by our local
guides and transfer to our hotel in Kiruna.
Tonight we will have dinner and a detailed
briefing about the challenge ahead.

29 March: Kauppinen to Tobacco Trail, 50km

After breakfast we will transfer to Kauppinen where we will meet and greet our Alaskan Huskies. Everyone will get their own sledge and husky team of four dogs for which they will be responsible for over the coming days. Once we are all ready we set off and travel around 50km across the frozen land towards our wilderness cabin for our first overnight stop. Late afternoon we will have the opportunity to go show shoeing/skiing.

30 March: Tobacco Trail to Sami village, 70km

We rise early to feed and then harness the dogs. We have a long and demanding day with 70km of mushing. We break for lunch half way before continuing on to our overnight tented camp Övre Soppero, Sami village. Tonight we cook together over an open fire keeping a close watch to see if we can spot the northern lights.

31 March: Tobacco Trail, 70km

Up early ready for another demanding day with 70km of mushing through the cold Lapland wilderness back to the wilderness camp. Tonight is our last chance to experience the brilliance of the Aurora Borealis dancing brightly above.

1 April: Tobacco Trail to Kauppinen, 50km

The final day with our dogs. After breakfast we start our journey back to basecamp. We say goodbye to our dogs this evening and enjoy an evening of celebrations after completing this incredible challenge.

2 April: Kiruna to London

Transfer back to Kiruna airport for our onward flight back to the UK.
